Instructions: Sometime before the service times you should receive an email from Christ Church which will contain an invitation to join both services. Five to ten minutes before the service time, click on the link in the email. When the Zoom program appears on your screen, click on the button that says you want to join using video, and click on the button that says you want to join using audio. **Then wait** for someone to open the meeting. When this happens, you will see familiar faces on the screen. At this point, any background noise or anything you say will be heard by everyone on the screen. To prevent this, you can click on the speaker icon to mute the speaker, but remember if you wish to speak, you will need to unmute the speaker.
