A Letter from Bishop Klusmeyer

Advent is a time of expectant waiting.

Too often, we use the time of Advent as a time of rushing around...from parties to stores, to concerts, to neighbors. We are constantly searching to find enough time to do all of the things we feel we want to get done.

When I was a young priest, we had been instructed that Advent was a 'Mini-Lent.' It was a time of 'a little' repentance, and a 'little bit' of fasting. Advent was a time of self-reflection and prayer...self-denial, and all of the rest...but not on the order of Lent. "Just a little bit."

Then, The Church recognized that Advent was a whole different animal. It wasn't a 'Mini-Lent.' It was, and is, a time of reflection and hopeful expectation.

With that in mind, I invite you to a time of hopeful waiting.

I invite you to an Advent of Compline.

We will meet on Zoom, Monday – Friday at 7 pm.

For those unfamiliar with Compline, it is a quiet time, preparing for the close of the day.
