Holy Week is the most important week of the entire year for Christians around the world. It begins with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, in which we see a peculiar power manifested in humility. It continues with Jesus' loving provision for his closest friends, as he gathers them on Maundy Thursday for a sacred meal that would sustain and give life to them in his absence, and he shows them the way of true greatness in service.

Then, darkness descends. While one of his friends is actively betraying him, Jesus prays in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. And when he gets up from his prayer, seeking the comfort of his companions, he is distressed to find that his closest friends could not stay awake with him even for one hour. Still, Jesus is compassionate, saying that he knew his friends wanted to be faithful to him; the problem is that, "the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." **Who does not recognize himself or herself in those words?**

Things then go from bad to worse, as officials mock him, soldiers beat him, a friend denies him, and the crowd that welcomed him on Palm Sunday clamors for his crucifixion. Yet, even as he is dying on Good Friday, Jesus prays the prayer that has both haunted and inspired the world ever since, "Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing." **How often Jesus could be saying the same about us today. And how often we perhaps need to pray the same for one another.**

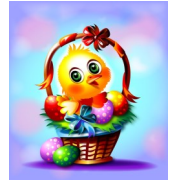
Things to Remember . . .
