## **CURRENT FINANCIAL STATUS OF CHRIST CHURCH**

During the pandemic we know that it is hard on individuals not to join each other on Sundays for worship. It is also hard for our church because we don't have weekly collections. Last month we reported a decrease of \$23,365.53 in contributions in comparison to last year. **This month we are reporting a decrease of \$22,630.53;** just a difference of \$735.00. This is not much but is a slight increase. Thank you!

Some of you have been mailing in contributions. It is greatly appreciated. If you would like to help support the church financially, it is easy. You can mail a check directly to the church at PO Box 1492, Clarksburg WV 26302 or you can E-Give through the Diocesan website with NO FEES! Just go to <http://www.wvdiocese.org/pages/aaegiving.html>. Just scroll down and click on the donate button by Bridgeport-St. Barnabas or Clarksburg-Christ Church.

**Did you know Christ Church applied for a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) Loan?** When the PPP Loan was announced this past spring, I quickly contacted the Vestry and was approved to apply for the loan on behalf of the Church. With this year's budget having a *deficit* of \$50,066.50 and not knowing how long we might be restricted on holding Church services, I felt it was important to apply. We were approved and on May 13, 2020 we received \$29,100. As of July 15, 2020, we used all the funds towards payroll and utilities. As soon as BB&T [Truist] launches the portal for forgiveness applications I will apply for forgiveness of the loan. If the loan is not forgiven the interest rate will be 1%.

## **STEWARDSHIP**

This is the time of year churches begin their stewardship campaigns for the upcoming year. Some people have a hard time understanding the meaning of 'stewardship'. According to *Google*, stewardship is defined as "the job of supervising or taking care of something, such as an organization or property." I once read that stewardship is about taking care of something you consider worth caring for and preserving. Isn't caring for and preserving YOUR Church something YOU want to do? I'm sure your answer is "yes".

Every fall Christ Church/St. Barnabas Chapel conducts a simple Stewardship Campaign or what some might refer to as an annual pledge campaign. Yes, it is important to financially support our church, but I personally feel there is more to stewardship than giving money. To me, stewardship is also caring for our church family and others. During this time of great anxiety it is important for us be better stewards – both financially and lovingly.

How might you show your caring for your church and church family? This is a great time to check in on others by phone, email, or maybe send a card; help out with sanitizing the church; help to keep the outside campuses clean of debris; and don't forget to continue financially supporting YOUR CHURCH.

Hopefully we will get back to normal soon, but in the meantime, let's strengthen our "stewardship muscles" and be good stewards!
